Welcome Artists!

You are invited to apply for the 59th Annual Kiwanis Art Fiesta sponsored by the Sacramento Suburban Kiwanis. It will take place the first weekend of June, Saturday, June 3 and Sunday, June 4, 2017. We will once again be hosting Art Fiesta at the Pavilions Shopping Center located at 563 Pavilions Lane, Sacramento, off Fair Oaks Boulevard near Howe Avenue.

As in previous years all applicants will be juried. New artists, please submit four photos (no slides) representative of your work as well as a photo of your display. If you are a returning artist, we still have your photos from previous years. If your work or media has changed significantly, or you haven't participated in the show for a couple of years, please send photos this year.

Returning Artists:

Space assignments will be prioritized by date of your application. Applying early is encouraged. Exhibiting in prior years is not a guarantee of acceptance. There are no refunds due to weather. Artists whose entries are postmarked by March 1, 2017 will be given priority of space assignments.

All Artists:

If you are accepted, we will cash your check upon receipt of your application. Again this year, if you choose to pay using your Visa or Mastercard, the card will be run beginning in April - not before. If we do not accept your application, you will be sent a refund for the full amount, or your card will NOT be charged.

All applicants must sign ALL pages of the application. Artists returning unsigned applications will not be considered regardless of when you submit your application, your prior year status, or jury recommendation, until all pages of your application are signed.

Sometimes multiple artists share a booth. Please send one application packet for EACH artist. You may send all applications in one envelope. If you mail your applications separately, payment must be included for the entire booth fee in one of the envelopes. Payment must be received before any of the applications will be considered.

We will gladly mail you as many announcement postcards and posters you need for your mailing list. Please indicate clearly on your application how many of each you would like.

Your booth fees directly benefit children's charities in the greater Sacramento area supported by Sacramento Suburban Kiwanis Club. We look forward to hearing from you and we look forward to a highly successful 59th Annual Kiwanis Art Fiesta at the Pavilions.

High standards and quality fine art have contributed to the success of Art Fiesta. Honoring this commitment, a limited number of each medium will be accepted and each artist's work will be juried. Please submit your application and if you are a new artist, or an artist who has not shown in the last few years, please submit photos of your work and display as soon as possible.

If you are accepted, the items you bring to the show will be compared with your photo entries. If there are discrepancies you may be asked to remove items from your display or you may be asked to remove the entire display. At such time your application fee is considered non-refundable.

You will not be charged a percentage of sales; **however we ask that you please donate one or more pieces of your artwork for our art auction.** The art auction will be held in conjunction with our Beaujolais Plus in the fall. **Proceeds from the Kiwanis Art Fiesta entry fees and the Beaujolais Plus benefit local charities.**

Please do not park, other than for loading and unloading, in Pavilions. Parking at Pavilions is reserved for your customers. Offsite parking is close by. Details will follow with the acceptance packet if you are invited to join this year's Kiwanis Art Fiesta.

Commitment:

Artisans agree to show up both days and be present **throughout** the show. SET UP IS TO BE COMPLETED BY 9:30 a.m. Electricity at Pavilions may not be available and power is **not** guaranteed. THERE IS NO RAIN DATE. REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN BECAUSE OF WEATHER (heat, wind, rain, etc).

Deadlines:

Applications are being accepted immediately. Acceptance letters will be sent out **beginning in March.**

Booth Sizes/Fees: Maximum of three spaces, any size combination, allowed per artisan.

Standard space:	\$150
Large space:	\$285 (A large space may NOT accommodate a canopy.)
Canopy space:	\$300 (If you bring and use a canopy, you must let us know and the space fee is \$300)

Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Credit cards will be charged beginning in April. If accepted you will receive an acceptance letter. We will send acceptance letters beginning in March. If you are not accepted you will receive a letter with your refund if paying by check-or your credit card will not be charged.

Responsibility:

Each artisan will be responsible for the protection of his or her own display and artwork. The sponsors (Sacramento Suburban Kiwanis, Donahue Schriber, Pavilions Management and merchants) will not be responsible for any loss or damage to materials or displays.

Eligibility:

Exhibitors agree to show their own original art. Resale items are not acceptable. No retail store merchants are permitted to exhibit. Cooperative galleries are not considered stores and may apply provided the artists who created the pieces are available to show their work during the weekend.

Cancellations/Refunds:

Cancellations and/or refunds will be considered on a case-by-case basis. There will be no refunds after May 22, 2017. Remember your entry fee benefits local community service projects and children's charities.
